Wheal Busy - Mrs. Burton will be taking the Year 3 /4 children to


Woodlands Farm Camp near Truro. They will experience a night time beaver walk, cheese and bread making, survival skills and cooking on a fire. Sounds amazing!

We are letting you know nice and early to give you plenty of time to save for these trips. We hope this helps give more children the opportunity to partake in these memorable activities.






Attendance

All families of Richard Lander School's partner Primary schools are warmly invited to an evening cor where the Pearl of Africa Children's Choir will be putting on a <u>spectacular</u> performance of African so dance.

On Monday 4th November, Richard Lander will once again be visited by the acclaimed choir, which is made up of mainly orphaned children who attend the Molly and Paul Childcare Schools in Uganda. The choir only visits Conwell once every two years as part of their fundrasing four, which throughout the course of its 10 weeks raises funds for a British registered charity that in turn directly supports the schools in Uganda providing education, clothing and homes for around 2000 children who would not otherwise be able to attend school.

Admission is free and there will be a voluntary contribution at the end – this is how funds are raised during the tour. There will also be a sale of African arts, crafts and jewellery during the interval – an opportunity to buy those early Christmas presents perhaps.

Richard Lander School has very close links with the Pearl of Africa Children's Choir.
