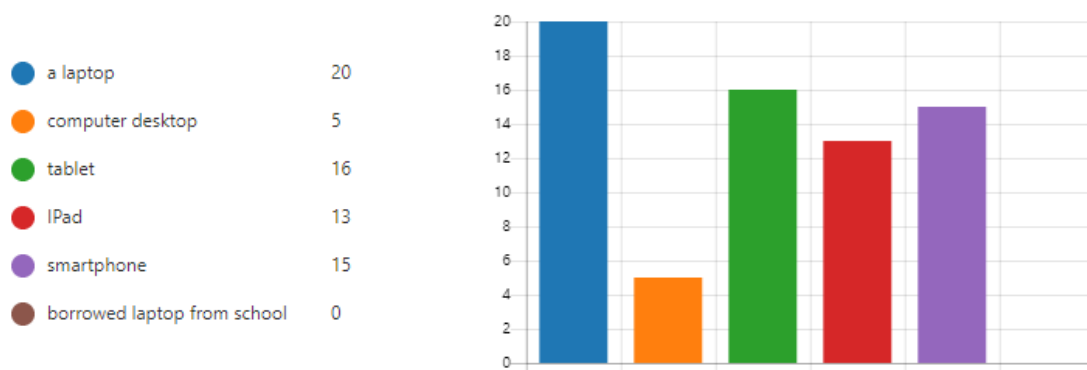

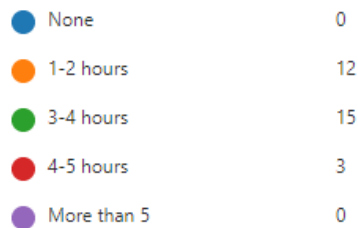

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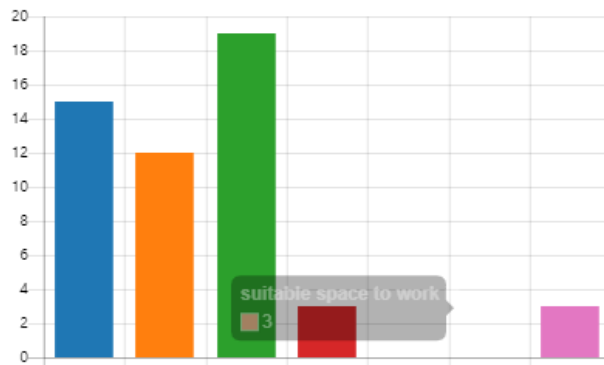

- ✓ *Teaching assistant story telling once a week*
- ✓ *Card home to all children*
- ✓ *More personal feedback videos to the children – need to adapt the key worker provision. TA's responsible in the afternoon to give teachers time to feedback.*
- ✓ *Ear phones given out to support children to focus at home*
